Fulbright Student Grants to France: ENS Paris-Saclay

Graduating college seniors, Master's, and PhD level candidates interested in a degree program and/or a research project at the prestigious and highly competitive Grande Ecole, Ecole normale supérieure Paris-Saclay (ENS Paris-Saclay).

Candidates to Master's degrees are particularly encouraged to apply.

ELIGIBLE FIELDS	Fundamental sciences, engineering sciences, social sciences and humanities
NUMBER OF AWARDS	2-4
LENGTH OF AWARDS	6-12 months
BENEFITS (MAINTENANCE AND TRAVEL)	Approximately 1000€ per month and a full tuition waiver from ENS Paris-Saclay. An additional 500€ per month from the Franco-American Commission, as well as a 1200€ travel allowance.
HOW TO APPLY	Applicants are required to first contact the ENS Paris-Saclay International Office (<u>ri-incoming@ens-paris-saclay.fr</u>) for information on the procedure to apply for the ENS Paris-Saclay international scholarship.
	A letter of affiliation signed by the relevant supervisor at ENS Paris-Saclay should be submitted with the application for applicants pursuing both degree-seeking and research projects.
	Second step: Apply to the Fulbright student program through the International Institute of Education (IIE) (http://us.fulbright.online.org). Applicants enrolling in a degree seeking program must apply to ENS Paris-Saclay as well once they have been confirmed as Fulbright grantees.

ABOUT ENS PARIS-SACLAY	The Ecole normale supérieure Paris-Saclay (ENS Paris-Saclay), a graduate school dedicated to preparing students for careers in research and higher education, is a selective school with a rigorous curriculum. It is a member of the Université Paris-Saclay.
	ENS Paris-Saclay offers Master's and doctoral degree programs in the fundamental sciences, humanities and social sciences, and engineering, with an emphasis on research and multidisciplinary perspectives.
	In 2020, ENS Paris-Saclay is moving to the Université Paris-Saclay campus, with new teaching and research departments, laboratories, and doctoral programs, and new opportunities for collaboration.
FRENCH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY	Except for the eight Master's programs delivered in English, an excellent knowledge of French is required for candidates interested in pursuing coursework. A basic knowledge of French may be sufficient for candidates proposing scientific research projects in one of ENS Paris-Saclay's laboratories.
